Working to end domestic abuse

What you will fund:

- **Emergency needs:** often women come to refuge with nothing but the clothes they wear. You can help us to provide them with toiletries, bedding and other emergency needs.
- **Outreach work:** Bromley & Croydon Women's Aid run outreach programmes in the community, which include Telephone Support and the Freedom Programme for survivors of domestic abuse.



- **Refuge:** BCWA organise many activities in refuges for both women and children.
- **Playrooms:** you can help BCWA Child Support Workers to run our fully-equipped playrooms in refuge, where kids can spend time together, drawing, playing and doing homework.
- **One Stop Shop:** BCWA co-ordinate and provide support at the One Stop Shop in Bromley, together with police officers, family law solicitors and representatives from Bromley Homeless Families Unit.
- **Outings and Trips:** Children visit museums, parks, libraries and amusement parks during Christmas, Easter and Summer Holidays with their mums and BCWA Child Support Workers.
- **Schools Programme:** BCWA run healthy and safe relationship programmes in primary schools that always need funding.

DID YOU KNOW?

- Domestic violence costs society roughly £16 billion per year. It costs the NHS almost £2 billion per year.
 - Every week 2 women are killed by their partners or ex-partners in the UK.
 - 1 in every 4 women have experienced or are experiencing some form of domestic abuse.
 - 1 in every 4 female victims of domestic abuse will attempt suicide.

Why a standing order:

For the donor

It allows you to budget your donations to a charity over the years. When you set up a standing order, you choose the amount of money you want to donate and how often to donate. It is really easy to change details, in case you want to cancel the payment or change the amount of money paid to Bromley & Croydon Women's Aid.

Your donations by standing order will allow us to plan long-term projects, and to help more and more women and children in the future. In addition, knowing we can rely on a long-term commitment of our supporters is important in promoting our work to other members of the community.

How set up a standing order:

You can either go to your bank's branch or do it online on your personal banking online page. You will need:

- Name of the recipient
 - Sort Code
 - Account Number
- Reference (a line to describe what are you paying)
 - Amount
 - Date of first payment
 - Frequency
 - End of the payments
